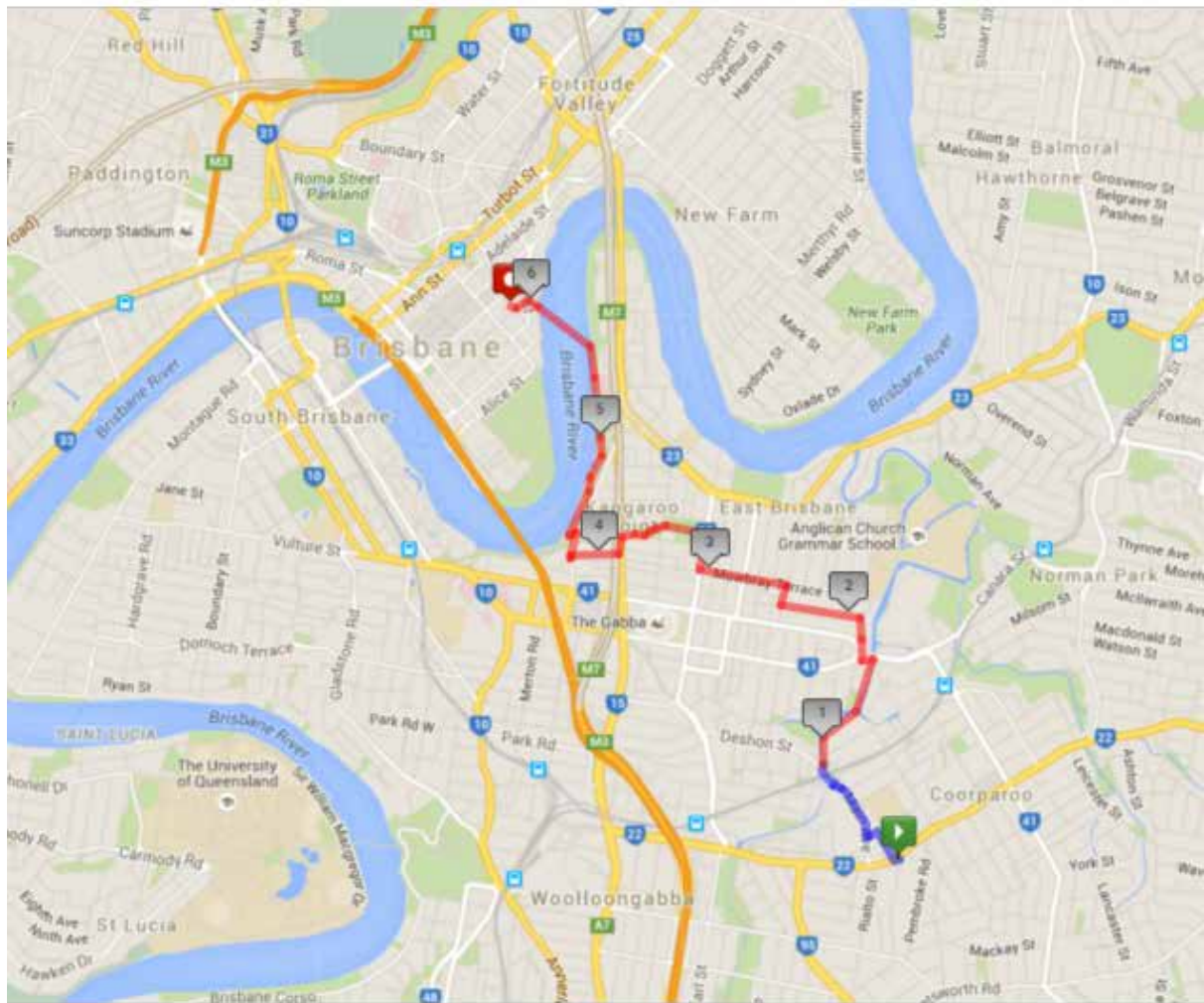














Year of Mercy Pilgrimage – St James' Coorparoo to the Cathedral of St Stephen










Distance	Directions	Photographs
0.0	<p>Start – St James’ Church, corner Kirkland Ave and Old Cleveland Road, Coorparoo. Park any vehicles in Kirkland Ave taking note of parking restrictions.</p> <p>Before beginning walking, stand on the steps of the Church and look at the view to the city.</p> <p>Begin walk by crossing Kirkland Ave and proceed to traffic lights on Old Cleveland Road. Cross Old Cleveland Road via traffic lights and turn left and walk to Baragoola Street</p>	
0.1	<p>As you enter Baragoola Street, look down the street. See the distinctive building with green panelling in the distance on the right. This is Villanova College.</p> <p>Proceed down street and turn left into Sixth Ave.</p>	
0.3	<p>Walk down the slope. You will see Easts Rugby League Club. Turn right to Main Ave.</p>	



	<p>To see the football oval (see picture) you will need to cross Main Ave.</p>	
0.6	<p>Continue walking on Main Ave on the right side. Avoid going on any side roads and make sure you go under the railway line. (One of the railway lines is a standard gauge freight line which connects the Port of Brisbane with the southern states.</p>	
0.8	<p>After passing under the railway bridge, turn into Norman Creek Greenway. A sign says "Wynnum Road 3.6" but note you are not going as far as Wynnum Road. Norman Creek and its Mangroves should be on your left. As you proceed, the playground will appear on your right and a skate bowl on your right. You will pass toilets on your right.</p>

1.7	<p>You will come to a busy road, Stanley Street East., Turn left and cross Norman Creek via a road bridge.</p> <p>Turn right into Caswell Street. Bates French Polishers and Upholsterer is on the corner.</p>	
1.8	<p>Walk up the slope. (Note - You will see a large volume of traffic turning from Vulture Street into Caswell Street and then turn into Stanley Street East.)</p> <p>Continue straight on Caswell Street into Stanley Tce. You will pass Vulture Street on your left and Bates Court (see photograph) on your right.</p>	
2.0	<p>Turn into Gresham Street, walk up a gentle slope. This street is a leafy street with some renovated houses as well as properties awaiting re-development.</p>

2.4	Turn right into Sinclair Street. Stay on right side of the street.	
2.6	You will come to Mowbray Tce. Note – the route requires you to turn left but you may wish to turn initially right and visit St Benedict's Church (see photograph). Diagonally across from the Church is a park which has water near the BBQ.	
2.8	Now you are on Mowbray Tce heading towards the city and gently going downhill. Cross LaTrobe Street at traffic lights and continue on Mowbray Tce. You will pass two former churches (see photographs). Note the current uses of these churches.

3.0	<p>Stay on Mowbray Tce until you reach a T junction and turn right into Wellington Road.</p> <p>See the right trim of <i>The Hospitality Store</i> (see photograph) on your right. You need to cross over Wellington Road and walk to the park. Be patient for a break in the traffic on Wellington Road.</p>	
3.1	<p>Cross over Baines Street and enter Raymond Park (see photograph). If the season is right you may see some mangoes.</p>	
3.5	<p>Once in the park do a gradual turn left and walk the full length of the park.</p> <p>You are heading towards Main Street of Kangaroo Point and in particular the Pineapple Hotel.</p>	
3.7	<p>On arrival at the Pineapple Hotel (see photograph – Baines Street view) cross Main Street via traffic lights and turn left (towards Woolloongabba).</p>

4.2	<p>From Main Street turn right into Lockerbie Street and walk up the gradual slope to Leopard Street. At the T junction, look left and you will see St Joseph's School.</p> <p>Next to the school is St Joseph's Church.</p> <p>Next you need to return to the junction of Lockerbie Street and Leopard Street. You need to proceed to River Tce which is an extension of Leopard Street. (If you are in Lockerbie Street, turn right.)</p> <p>Cross over River Tce.</p>	 
4.4	<p>At Scout Place (see picture) there is a picnic shelter and a set of stairs.</p>

	<p>The start of the stairs is near a sign labelled <i>The Cliff Broadwalk</i> (see photograph). Descend these stairs.</p>	
4.5	<p>The stairs level out and you need to turn right down a new set of steel stairs (see two photographs).</p> <p>At the bottom you are just slightly above the Brisbane River. Turn right and proceed downstream on the footpath (and avoid the bike path).</p>

5.0	<p data-bbox="320 232 679 441">Keeping the river on your left you will pass the Riverlife Café. This building is a former naval store. Look for the 1974 flood marker which is attached to this café.</p> <p data-bbox="320 947 679 1120">As you leave the Riverlife Café behind you, look up and you will see high on the right St Vincent's Hospital (see photograph).</p>	 <p>The top photograph shows the exterior of the Riverlife Café, a two-story building with light-colored corrugated metal siding. The entrance is open, flanked by large display windows showing various items. There are several posters and signs on the sidewalk in front of the entrance.</p> <p>The bottom photograph shows a view of St Vincent's Hospital, a large multi-story brick building with many windows, situated on a hillside. In the foreground, the roof and side of the Riverlife Café building are visible, showing its corrugated metal structure and a dark brown double door.</p>

5.6	<p>Keep walking downstream to the Thornton Street Ferry. If you catch a <i>CityFerry</i> (blue in colour), you will need to purchase a ticket with your GoCard or cash.</p> <p>Alternatively you can catch a <i>CityHopper</i> ferry (red in colour) for free but this service is less frequent.</p> <p>Your destination is Eagle Street. Check with the Ferry driver to confirm that the ferry is going to Eagle Street.</p>	
5.9	<p>On arrival on at Eagle Street wharf, walk up the gangplank, and then turn left and walk to a set of stairs (see photograph).</p>	
5.95	<p>Walk up the stairs (see photograph) and walk straight ahead (Il Centro will be on your left, and a Coffee Club will be on your right) and proceed to the traffic lights.</p>

6.0	Now use the traffic lights to cross Eagle Street and Charlotte Street and walk to the Cathedral which is diagonally opposite (see photograph).	
6.05	Enter the Cathedral precinct via the concrete steps off Charlotte Street.	
6.15	<p>The <i>Door of Mercy</i> is on the opposite side of the Cathedral near the St Stephen's Chapel.</p> <p>End of walk. Total Distance 6.15km</p>
