Our Commitment

- **Service-focused:** A place where we help others.

How Church Workers Should Behave

Church Workers will always:

- Be kind and friendly to everyone.
- Listen carefully when you talk.
- Treat everyone fairly.
- Respect your privacy.
- Follow the rules to keep you safe.
- Report if something doesn't seem right.

What Church Workers Must Not Do

Church Workers will never:

- Hurt you in any way.
- Put you in a dangerous situation.
- Say mean things to you or about you.
- Ignore you or your feelings.
- Share your secrets without your permission (unless to keep you safe).
- Show favouritism (play favourites).
